

# Can I get an updated COVID-19 shot?

Find the group that describes you in the graphic below.\*



6 years to 64 years old



65 years and older†



Immunocompromised people††

If you're 6+ and you've already gotten an updated (bivalent) shot, **you don't need another at this time.**

If you're 65+ or immunocompromised, and you've already gotten an updated (bivalent) shot, **you are eligible for a second updated shot.**



\*Children 6mo-less than 5 years should get a total of 3 COVID-19 shots, including at least 1 updated COVID-19 shot.

\*Children 5 years should get a total of 1 updated (Pfizer-BioNTech) or 2 updated (Moderna) COVID-19 shots.

†People 65+ can get a second shot 4 months after their 1st shot

††Immunocompromised people can get a second shot 2 months after their 1st shot

## Why should I get an updated COVID-19 shot?

- 1 Updated shots help protect against variants like Omicron
- 2 Everyone benefits from updated COVID-19 shots
  - ✓ Even for people who have had COVID already
  - ✓ And even for people who already got boosted
- 3 Updated shots help protect people around us



**The bottom line: Updated shots energize your immune system** to improve protection against COVID-19. You should get the most up-to-date COVID shot to protect yourself and those around you.
